What You Need to Bring

At each monthly visit we need to see the following: **Dated WIC print out** or your up to date **WIC App**. (You do not need to be a WIC client) or **A statement of your wages** from your employer, or a current **letter from the Transitional Assistance Office**, an **ID**, and **Proof of address** on Cape Cod or the Islands (utility bill).
